

These photographs do not just narrate stories, they enable the viewer to pass the state of mere spectator and develop an actual connection with the human behind the image, with her hopes, her energy, the true manifestation of her being. The voices of these Albanian young women and girls can now be heard, their desires can be felt, their aspirations understood, whether they dream of becoming an artist, a doctor, a lawyer, or just a strong independent woman making their parents proud.
